Reggio Emilia Study Tour 2019

November 2019

It is with pleasure that the R.E. Provocations committee invite you to join us on the 2019 Study Tour to Reggio Emilia, Italy. As a member of the International Network of Reggio Children we are organising a delegation from New Zealand to visit Italy and see first-hand the Reggio Philosophy and Educational Approach to teaching and learning within their Preschools and Infant Toddler Centres.

Your week in Reggio Emilia is truly a wonderful experience, with participants arriving with a host of questions and often leaving with many more. We have been taking these study tours since 1995 and there has always been an element of surprise as the week unfolds. You will visit the town of Reggio Emilia led by the Friends of Reggio Children, engage with presentations to provoke your thinking and challenge your practice, visit to an Infant and Toddler centre and be immersed in a Preschool for a morning. We also visit the REMIDA Centre which is full of recycled resources as well as the Loris Malaguzzi School.

Reggio Children are very open and willing to share their journey. There is always something to be discovered, something to challenge your thinking, something to be emotional about, as you weave your way through the week of encounters, provocations and dialogues.



Costs

- ▶ Shared Twin Room - **\$3,900** per person
- ▶ Single Room - **\$4,250** per person
- ▶ The cost for accompanying persons not attending the course is **\$850**

All prices are in New Zealand dollars

Our Study Tour package includes:

- ▶ Accommodation for 7 nights (9-16 Nov) at Hotel Europa
- ▶ Airport transfers to Reggio Emilia (If travelling with the group)
- ▶ Conference registration costs
- ▶ Daily buffet breakfast at Hotel Europa
- ▶ Buffet lunch and light refreshments during full conference days (Monday-Friday)
- ▶ Walking tour of Reggio Emilia

Payments

- ▶ A deposit of **\$1,000 per person** is required with registration and **\$250** for any accompanying persons
- ▶ 50% of the tour and accommodation cost is required by 10 July 2019
- ▶ Payment of the balance of tour and accommodation cost is required by 31 September 2019

Receipts will be issued upon receipt of payments

Cancellation Terms

The following cancellation criteria stands so please make yourself fully aware of this:

- ▶ Cancellation after the 10 July until 31 September 2019, 50% of amount paid
- ▶ Cancellation after the 31 September 2019, no refund

Travel Insurance

Travel insurance is a **mandatory requirement** of joining this study tour. Confirmation of insurance is to be provided with your final payment. If you cancel after the airfares have been paid, your travel insurance will have to be used.

Exchange rate

All costs are based on the exchange rate as of the **1 June 2019** and are subject to change until paid in full.

Accommodation

We have arranged accommodation at **Hotel Europa**, which is a modern, four-star hotel, set within central Reggio Emilia. Options include a share twin or a single room configuration. A full breakfast is included.

Flights

If you wish to travel with the group, we are happy to support you in arranging your flights through our travel agent. **The airfares are not included in the study tour costs above.**

Tour Dates

The dates for the international conference are from the **10th – 15th November 2019**. If you are travelling with the group, we plan to arrive in Reggio Emilia a day early on the 9th November. This would require you, to leave New Zealand on Friday 8th November. The group will begin the journey back to New Zealand on 16th November.
